Promfest is a drug and alcohol free post-prom event open to all MCHS juniors and seniors. For those juniors and seniors who attend Prom, his/her guest is also welcome at Promfest.

The Promfest committee and members of the Morris community have been working to present an exciting event full of memories for your student. This year's Promfest will be held at Enchanted Castle in Lombard. This is a lock-in type facility and the only way the students can participate is to arrive at the event via buses provided by Promfest. Attendees will be involved in activities that include arcade games, laser tag, mini-bowling, mini-golf, and bumper cars. Pizza and pop are included and will be served during the first hour. The snack bar will be open to purchase ice cream, nachos, Icees, and cookies. Students and guests will need to bring extra money in order to purchase extra snacks.

Students and guests attending Prom will be given their change of clothes at the end of the dance. They will change their clothes at Ashton Place and pack their clothes in a provided bag. They will load the bags on the bus as they load the bus to go to Enchanted Castle. Promfest will not be responsible for any lost, misplaced, or missing items.

Our goal is to ensure students have a fun and safe experience. All bags are subject to inspection and possible search completed by school administration, Interquest Canine Detection, chaperones, and/or local authorities. All students attending Promfest may be subject to alcohol tests administered by the Morris Police.

Those students wishing to forgo the Prom will board a bus at the rear of the high school and will be driven to the event. No student will be allowed to bring any food, beverage or additional baggage on the Promfest bus. If a student arrives with such items, he/she will be asked to dispose of them or place them in his/her vehicle. This bus is scheduled to leave MCHS at approximately 9:00 P.M. We will begin boarding the bus at 8:45 P.M. on the evening of April 29.

All buses will arrive back at MCHS in the circle drive between 3:30 and 4:00 A.M. on April 30.
